WHERE: Outside the west entrance of the Gateway Arch Visitor Center. (Location will be moved to the Mezzanine inside the Visitor Center if it is raining.)

COST: Free to attend

PARKING: For guests participating in the volunteer fair, the Stadium East Garage is the [preferred Arch visitor parking location](#), with a discounted rate (\$9) for five hours — if pre-purchased at least a day in advance. Downtown metered parking and other surface lots and garages are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
