



'PDM' Letters Removed From Arch Strut

The three "PDM" letters on the stabilizing strut on the Gateway Arch are removed Tuesday and the National Park Service restored the \$225,000 deduction it had made for an advertising fee in a payment to the prime contractor, Jefferson National Expansion Memo-

rial superintendent LeRoy R. Brown termed the removal "a fine display of affirmative action" on the part of the subcontractor, Pittsburgh-Des Moines Steel Company.
